One of the main questions we ask ourselves after each ayat is how we can apply this in our lives and what harm does a lack of this quality cause. This allows us to self-reflect as well and try to find ways where we can incorporate the Quranic teachings in our lives.



Quran and Islamic Studies Integration:

Inshallah the meaning and explanation of the Ayaat of Surah Al-Furqan will be aligned with Hadith and examples from the lives of the Sahaba and Sahabiat. The students will also discuss how the lessons in these ayaat can be and should be applied in our daily lives today. Students are encouraged to take notes on the content as effective note-taking can improve active listening as well as comprehension of the material and retention.
