We talked about the Hadith which states that the rights of a mother are three times more than that of a father as well as the Hadith that clearly says Allah's happiness is in our father's happiness. The current generation is living at a time when unfortunately respect has come something of the past but Alhamdulillah I have to say my Tariqah students understand the fine line between respect and disrespect as well as respect and disobedience.

Last week we discussed what it means to be patient and what is the difference between complaining, venting and actually asking for help. Our focus this week will be on Hadith that are related to Patience and we are using Riyadh us Saliheen as a resource. I have given the students a packet that has all of the hadith related to Patience in Riyadh-us-Saliheen and they are required to bring it with them in every class. This week we are continuing with the hadith and the goal is to finish the Hadith related to Sabr in Riyadh us Saliheen by Thursday Inshallah. We will be reading each Hadith and translating it word for word and learning the meaning and explanation. Students are recommended to take notes.
